All Horses 6 months or older must be accompanied by a negative Coggin's test (original or copy) issued within the last 12 months. Any horse not having proper Coggin's papers will not be allowed to stay on the grounds. NO EXCEPTIONS!! All fees will be forfeited for said horse. 30 Day Health certificate for ALL out of state horses.

There will be a \$25.00 charge for returned checks plus bank service fee's.

SAHIBA also holds a club trail ride each fall as well as participates in local horse activities such as Georgetown's Festival of the Horse and Breed weekends at the Kentucky Horse Park.

SAHIBA Arabian Spring Show - May 14-16, 2010

Our Class A all Arabian/Half-Arabian show is now expanded to 3 days! It will be held May14-16, 2010. It has a full list of Arabian and Half-Arabian classes as well as Dressage, Sport Horse, Trail and Reining.

SAHIBA Sheiks N Shrieks - Oct. 16, 2010 (tentatively)

Our next Open show, Sheiks N Shrieks is a one day show with a fun, family atmosphere. We offer classes for practically everyone, from Walk Only classes for all ages, Walk/Trot/Canter classes for all levels to Open classes. We also offer fun classes, including Costume.

Arabian Classes

Classes denoted with * qualify for the KBIF points. You must be a KAHABA member before the show in order to count the points. Visit the KY Arabian & Half Arabian Breeders Alliance (KAHABA) website at www.KyArabian.com for membership application, other forms and further details.

This show is a WPCSA Bronze show (applied for). For WPCSA classes (12, 16, 19, 21, 23, 26, 32, 42):

WPCSA BREED CLASSES (Article 110.2)

Animals are to be shown in hand at a walk and a trot except in group classes. Purebred Welsh to be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Half-Welsh to be judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on Welsh breed type, disposition and manners.

WPCSA WELSH ENGLISH PLEASURE (Article 112.3)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners movement and style: 25 % on breed type and conformation. Working class to be judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA LEADLINE WALK (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk-trot, and leadline walk-trot poles.

WPCSA WALK-TROT (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk, walk-trot poles.

HELMET RULE FOR WPCSA EXHIBITORS:

Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

The Tails of Windy Meadows

Kentucky State Fair World's Championship Horse Show Pleasure and Park Horse Qualifying Requirements

Beginning in 2008, all horses in American Saddlebred Show Pleasure, American Saddlebred Country Pleasure and American Saddlebred Park will be required to qualify to show at the Kentucky State Fair World's Championship Horse Show. Horses entered in these divisions must have been shown in a minimum of six(6) classes, in three (3) or more different horse shows, in the same division in which they will show at the World's Championship Horse Show, either under saddle or in harness, beginning July 1, 2008, through June 30, 2009. At the World's Championship Horse Show, the same horse may not show in the Junior Exhibitor and the Adult class, nor may they show in "Under Saddle" and "Driving" or in more than one age division.

Arrival Information

Stabling will be available no earlier than 4:00 PM on Friday, March 12th.
Departure no later than 7:00 PM on Sunday, March 14th unless other arrangements are made.

Entries in Over Fences classes must be entered by 7:30 am Saturday.
Entries in Trail classes must be entered by 7:30 am Sunday. Entries in any halter/in-hand classes must be entered by 8 am each morning.

Show ring attire is not required for the fun show, except in Equitation classes. However, your entry should be as neat and clean as possible. Approved safety helmets are strongly advised for exhibitors 18 and under. Also proper shoes with a heel (no sneakers) are also advised.

Training devices are permitted; however, no actions enhancing devices will be allowed. Whip abuse or cruelty of any kind will be cause for immediate dismissal from the show grounds and all awards and fees paid will be forfeited.

ALL CLASSES WILL FOLLOW USEF RULES AND GUIDELINES. THE JUDGE MAY MAKE CHANGES FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE ENTRANTS.

Any questions pertaining to open classes, please inquire at show office.

Stallions may not be shown by anyone under 14 years of age, except for WPCSA entries. Any stallion, regardless of the age of the handler, will be excused if it poses a hazard to its handler or other exhibitors.

Classes 25, 26 & 27 - The rider may not cross enter into any Walk/Trot or Walk/Trot/Canter classes.

Classes 28 & 29 - The rider may not cross enter into any walk/trot/canter classes.

Classes 43 & 44 - Required to walk and any other favorite gait, besides Canter.

Riders/Handlers may use Saddleseat, Western or Hunt attire & tack in any class, unless certain attire & tack is called for.

Generation Gap, class 122 must have at least a 10-YEAR space between the ages of the riders. Younger riders go first. The older riders go second
